Your application must be received no later than March 9, 2012.

To be eligible for this student appointment you must be enrolled for at least part-time attendance in an accredited school, college, technical school / institute, or other post-secondary educational facility. You must be at least 16 years of age to be employed.

If you are a selected candidate, you will enter the Student Temporary Employment Program, and your employment is meant to continue through to the completion of your education and will then come to an end. This is an opportunity for you to gain valuable on-the-job experience while attending school. We are flexible with you on your work schedule. You may work part-time while attending classes or you may work between semesters only. You are also able to work full-time during school breaks.

Applicants selected for this position will be responsible for mapping and cartographic functions, to include preparing and revising maps and geo-referencing new imagery using computerized Geographic Information System (GIS) data. The Cartographic Technician will be responsible for preparing and making minor editing revisions of legal descriptions used in deeds, warranty deeds, tract maps and other legal documents though applied knowledge of technical cartographic principles and practices to acquire, manage and manipulate spatial data.

To qualify for placement as a GS-1374-04 Cartographic Technician, you must have successfully completed two years of study that included at least 12 semester hours in any combination of courses such as cartography, relevant mathematical and statistical sciences, or related sciences (e.g., physical geography or geodesy). Not more than six of the 12 semester hours should have been in mathematics or statistics.
