The Geography Section invites Abstracts for two types of presentation.

**Oral Presentation** Illustrated, oral papers on any aspect of Geography are welcome. Presentation of Graduate student in-progress work is especially encouraged; this meeting offers a friendly venue for a student to make a first professional presentation. Presenters should assume that the audience has a broad basic understanding of the geography discipline. A PowerPoint projector and computer will be available and papers should be 15 minutes, plus 5 minutes for discussion.

**Poster** A poster tends to be less formal than an oral paper and allows for extended one-on-one discussions. A poster can be particularly useful for obtaining feedback on in-progress work or work involving high-detail graphics that do not project well. A poster should (1) focus on no more than three points, (2) use only a minimum amount of text, (3) rely heavily on graphics, and (4) be 48 inches x 48 inches. Poster presenters should stand by their posters during the morning coffee break.

## Geography Abstracts are due by Friday, January 24, 2014. Register by that same date for lowest registration fees.
