

PSU ASPRS GIS/Remote Sensing Research Scholarship

This scholarship is to support members purchasing imagery, hardware, software, or any other expenses incurred conducting geographic research.

Amount: Up to \$500. It is the student's responsibility to cover any remaining expenses if the total request is not awarded.

Deadline: March 26, 2010

Qualification:

- 1. PSU ASPRS active student members.
- 2. Data/equipment/software must be related to Remote Sensing or GIS.
- 3. Travel and other research expenses are also eligible.
- 4. Applicant must have an endorsement from a PSU faculty member.

Responsibilities:

- 1. Acknowledge support from PSU ASPRS in any research reports/publications.
- 2. Present to the PSU ASPRS colloquium on what was gained from your scholarship funding during the Fall 2010 or Winter 2011 terms.

To apply: Send a one-page proposal to the president of PSU ASPRS, Brian Block (<u>bblock@pdx.edu</u>), **and** the faculty adviser, David Banis (<u>dbanis@pdx.edu</u>), with the following information:

- 1. A brief summary of project, expected results, and intended use of monies requested.
- 2. A reference statement from the faculty supervising research.
- 3. Estimates for any data/equipment/software or other expenses.
- 4. Purchase information (e.g., vendor's contact information if applicable).
